

Privacy Policy for the use of the “VENUIQ” app

1. Who is responsible for data processing and who can I contact?

2. What personal data is processed, for what purposes and on what legal basis?

The app is used solely to enable you to get in touch and exchange ideas with participants and speakers registered in the app for the ‘Kommunale Sommergespräche’ event. In addition, you can use it to obtain general information about the event (such as the programme or the shuttle timetable), although this general information is also available on the website www.sommergespraeche.at. Data processing is based on our legitimate interests in promoting networking before and during the event, in accordance with Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR. You are, of course, free to object to such use of your data within the app, and we will proactively inform you of this separately before you are registered as a participant.

When you register for the event via the Kommunale Sommergespräche website, you provide the following categories of data: name, company, role and professional contact details.

3. Who receives my data?

Only a few selected employees of Kommunalkredit Austria AG have access to the data.

Furthermore, the software provider Majero Ltd Limited, Charter House, Sandford Street, Lichfield, WS13 6QA, England, stores and processes the data on behalf of and in accordance with the instructions of the data controllers and is contractually obliged to treat your data confidentially and to process it only for the purposes of providing the service. As the UK has an adequacy decision in accordance with Article 45 of the GDPR, there is an adequate level of protection for the processing of personal data.

4. How long will my data be stored?

The data in the app will be deleted once the app is deactivated. The app can be used for a limited period of approximately up to 4 weeks before the event and up to 2 months after the event has ended. The data will therefore be automatically deleted at the latest after 3 months have elapsed.

5. Am I obliged to provide data?

Registration for and attendance at the event are independent of downloading and using the app. Downloading the app and registering within it are therefore voluntary.

6. What data protection rights do I have?

You have the right to access, rectify, erase or restrict the processing of your stored data, the right to object to the processing, and the right to data portability in accordance with the provisions of data protection law (see Article 15 et seq. of the GDPR).

Furthermore, you may withdraw your consent at any time and without giving a reason, in order to prevent the continued use of your personal data that was collected and used on the basis of a declaration of consent.

If you believe that we are breaching statutory data protection regulations when processing your data, we ask you to contact us so that we can address your concerns.
